## **Honoring God**

Revelation 4:10,11 tells us that all creatures in heaven and earth will honor and praise God for who He really is – our Creator and Sustainer.

the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne, and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say:

> "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being".

We honor God by giving Him respect, adoration, praise, submission, and obedience that are due to Him. We honor God with our lips and our hearts.

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment – Matthew 22:37, 38.

- Propel you and the United Methodist Church forward to live as a reflection of Him
- Move in the United Methodist Church to obey and honor God and to be God's light in the world
