Dear Member of Annual Conference,

This year the Central and Southeast Districts have graciously offered to host the 2011 Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference. On **May 19-22, 2011, our 225th Annual Conference convenes back at the Greater Philadelphia Expo Center** at Oaks, PA. The theme for our Conference – Journeying with the Poor – is one of the four foci of The United Methodist Church and is particularly relevant to these difficult times through which we as a world-wide church are journeying.



We are fortunate to have Rudy Rasmus, an emergent messenger and co-pastor with his wife Juanita at the St. John's United Methodist Church in Houston, Texas, as our keynote speaker. He is the author of the newly released book, *Touch, Pressing Against the Wounds of a Broken World*. He began the church in 1992 with only nine members and St. John's has grown to more than 9,000 members—3,000 of the members are currently or were formerly homeless. The church is one of the most culturally diverse congregations in the country. Pastor Rudy will focus our thoughts on journeying with the poor.
