

Clergy and Candidacy Mentor Training

Conference-wide training will be offered to all clergy in full connection (including part-time local pastors who have completed the course of study) at Wesley UMC in Bethlehem on **Thursday**, **December 13**, from 9 AM to 12 PM.

The UMC Book of Discipline requires that all clergy and candidacy mentors be trained and then retrained every four years. This three-hour open training suffices for both but requires advance registration.

Attendees should bring a wi-fi-enabled device (preferably one bigger than a cell phone) to use during the training.

- · All mentors assigned to a candidate who have not yet taken the training.
