Information



The Place and the Need



- The southern-most town in Maryland, located on the eastern shore of Chesapeake Bay
- *“The Crab Capital of the World”*
- Population of 2,600

Hurricane Sandy – October 29, 2012

- Struggling with a depressed economy when Sandy struck; attempting to transition from a seafood economy to tourism
- At least 350 homes damaged by intense winds and 5 feet of water flooding the town



Mission Trip Dates and Transportation

If you cannot be in Crisfield for the entire trip, that is OK. Just come when you can, and depart when you must.

Living Accommodations - 2 Options

All options are within only a couple of miles of each other

#1 Daugherty Creek Conference Center at Janes Island State Park

HQ for meals, devotions, meetings, fellowship, etc.

- Four bedrooms
 - 2 furnished with two sets of bunk beds / shared bathroom
 - 2 furnished with a queen and a single bunk bed, with private bathroom (reserved for the married folks)
- Fully-equipped kitchen (dishwasher!)

You will need to provide their own towels and bed linens – pillows and blankets available (but recommend you bring your own)





View From the Upstairs Deck

#2 Captain Tyler Motel

- Rooms with 2 full-sized beds, to sleep 2
- Rooms with 1 bed – (Queen or King)
- Microwave and refrigerator
- Cable TV
- Nothing fancy, but clean and comfortable
- Hotel staff is generally not around, but are very hospitable when they are



Costs

Includes housing and all meals, with dinner one evening at a local restaurant – likely the *Chesapeake Crab House & Tiki Bar* on the waterfront

- Janes Island Conference Center - \$75 per person
- Captain Tyler Motel
 - Single occupancy - \$149
 - Double occupancy - \$99
(Double occupancy rate only applies IF the hotel room is occupied by 2 people during all nights.)

We have access to the Conference Center after 5 pm on April 25th. The trip price is greatly subsidized by grants to encourage participation . . . and if you can arrive on Thursday, April 25, that fourth night is FREE at either location.

Construction supplies provided by grants.

Transportation costs to be borne by the participants themselves.

Stuff to Bring Along

- Truck and tools if you have them. Label tools with your name or other distinguisher
- Work clothes, work shoes, work gloves, hat
 - Be prepared to get dirty
 - Clothes could get ruined
 - Check the forecast –could be cold
- Protective eyeglasses/goggles
- Insect repellent – YES, even though it is April
- Any favorite, can't-live-without snacks
- If not at hotel: pillow, sheets, blanket and bath towel
- Clothes appropriate for Sunday morning worship at a Crisfield UMC
