Mr. David Koch is concluding his second four-year term as Lay Leader of the Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference. A new Conference Lay Leader needs to be identified. In the interest of fairness and openness to God's will, the process outlined below is being implemented so that willing and qualified persons interested in serving God in this way, may be identified. All persons are urged to prayerfully consider this matter and share the information with other persons.

Each person receiving a minimum of ten (10) written nominations will be considered at a meeting of the Board of Lay Ministry in February 2022 and brought before the 2022 Laity Session of Annual Conference on Saturday morning, April 4, 2022. The Laity Session will finalize the nomination after which it will be taken to the Annual Conference for a consensus vote.

A full description of the Conference Lay Leader position can be found in *The Book of Discipline*, ¶607. The following is an overview of that description:

- The Conference Lay Leader shall have the general responsibility in: 1.) developing the advocacy role for laity in the life of the Church; 2.) increasing the participation of laity in the sessions and structure of the Annual Conference; and 3.) encouraging laypersons in the general ministry of the Church.

  - The Extended Cabinet
  - The Board of Lay Ministry (Chair)
  - The Conference Committee on Leadership (Nominations)
  - The Conference Committee on Episcopacy
  - The Commission on Conference Sessions
  - The Connectional Table
  - The Association of Conference Lay Leaders
  - The Northeast Jurisdiction Association of Conference Lay Leaders
- Helpful qualifications
  - Love of God
  - Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing
  - Availability to participate in events and meetings (daytime and evenings)
  - Ability and willingness to travel throughout the Annual Conference
  - Demonstrated leadership and teamwork skills

All persons will be considered regardless of current leadership positions they now hold.
