

Measles is Preventable!

Measles is one of the most contagious diseases. You can get measles by being in a room where an infected person was, even up to 2 hours after they leave.

Measles is spread through tiny droplets in the air when an infected person breathes, coughs, or sneezes



Symptoms:

- Cough
- Runny nose
- Fever
- Rash
- Pink eye

Measles is so contagious that 9 in 10 unvaccinated people may get it if exposed

1 out of 5 unvaccinated people with measles may be hospitalized

Measles can cause serious problems like pneumonia, brain damage, or even death

How to Get Vaccinated

- Get vaccinated at your doctor's office or at participating retail pharmacies. Many locations offer no-cost vaccines, and most insurance plans cover the vaccine.
