During National Domestic Violence Awareness Month in October the Eastern PA Conference Domestic Violence Committee will explore the physical, emotional and social impacts of trauma related to domestic violence. The weekend training event will feature presentations, discussions and workshops led by resource experts, advocates, and survivors.

Dr. Allie King (pictured right), a researcher at Drexel University in Philadelphia, will keynote our event. She is a family therapist at the Center for Family Intervention Science (CFIS) at Drexel University, where she uses therapeutic interventions to help children recover from experiences of exposure to domestic violence.

A "Voices of Survivors" panel discussion will engage survivors in sharing their experiences and learnings about overcoming trauma from domestic and intimate-partner violence.
