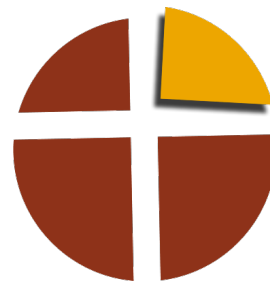
To that end, the expected outcomes to this workshop are as follows:
