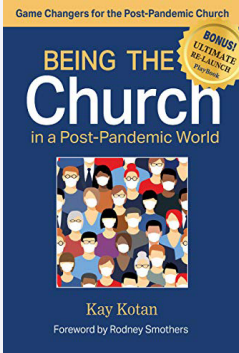

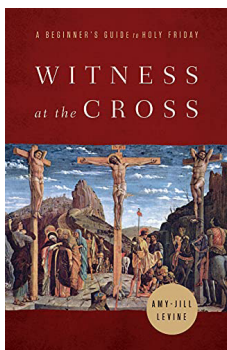
***Being the Church in a Post-Pandemic World: Game Changers for the Post-Pandemic Church* by Kay Kotan**

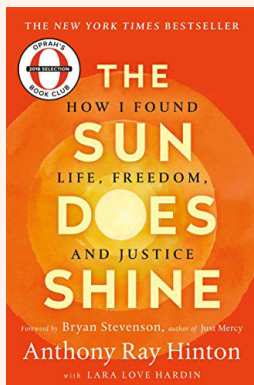
***Witness at the Cross: A Beginner's Guide to Holy Friday* by Amy-Jill Levine**

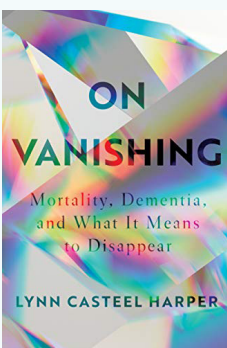
***The Sun Does Shine: How I Found Life and Freedom on Death Row* by Anthony Ray Hinton**
